The Studio took all the needed supplies and set up creation stations at each location they visited. They staffed the tables and lent their know-how and creative abilities to assist others in the junkbot-building process! These finished products then joined the army of junkbots for the exhibit at Explosion of the Arts on October 4 in downtown Napoleon. It was there that Pastors Janine Shearer and Juli Lejman-Guy and shared the poignant message that God created us, and just like these robots, God takes all our pieces and turns them into something good. After a two-year break due to COVID-19 concerns, the Women's Guild of Filling Homes once again hosted the Festival of Tables fundraiser on September 24.

The event allows volunteers to host their own with a license to decorate it to whatever theme they wish. He or she sells 7 additional tickets to the table at a cost of \$15 apiece. This year's event showed off the creativity of 10 such hostesses with themes like "Pets Enrich Our Lives", "Barbie", "Daisy, Daisy" and "Easter Bunny Tea Party".

Gene Zenz provided live music for the entertainment of the guests, and the luncheon's menu featured beef courtesy of a donation from the Cattleman's Association.

The proceeds from the event, amounted to \$2,400 and was donated entirely for the benefit of Filling Homes' residents. Special food molds are slated for purchase. The molds are designed to shape the food of residents who require a pureed diet into portions resembling the food itself. For instance, pureed chicken with the use of the food molds will take the shape of a chicken Leg. This will enhance the dining experience of these Residents by making the food more identifiable and appetizing. Monies raised over the cost of the food molds will go to purchase updated colorful dinnerware for use by all residents.
