

Advocacy Efforts Prove Successful

For more than a year and a half Filling Home has been an active member of a statewide coalition of agency providers of services to those living with intellectual and developmental


disabilities. The Coalition first came together to strategize and implement coordinated legislative advocacy efforts with the goal of positively influencing Medicaid reimbursement rates in Ohio's proposed biennium budget.

Across the state and at key times during the budget approval process, agency staff and leadership were joined by Board Members, families and those receiving services in sending thousands of letters to state legislators and influencers, providing both written an in-person testimony, and arranging agency tours, visits and zoom calls. The budget was approved during the last days of June with positive results for our agencies over the course of the next two fiscal years.

After more than three decades of lagging reimbursement rates, the state budget now contains unprecedented rate increases for our Intermediate Care Facilities as well as for our community-based services. These rate increases will enable Filling Home to have less reliance on Foundation assets to assist with operating costs, help us meet rising inflation and positively affect our ability to recruit and retain qualified staff in the numbers needed for the health, safety, security and enjoyment of those in our care.

We are truly thankful for all those who joined in this tremendous effort and look forward to the many opportunities this funding will provide in the lives of those we serve.

DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPTMENT RENTAL

In the past, The Society for the Handicap provided durable medical equipment rental to Henry County Residents from the Filling Home Community Center Building. They ended this service in the fall of 2021. In April of 2023, Filling Home Community Center resumed Durable medical equipment rentals. Durable medical equipment rentals are available Monday through Friday 8am-12pm at the Filling Home Community center located at 470 Independence Dr. Napoleon, Ohio. Low-cost, durable medical equipment can be rented for 60 days and extended, if needed. The Durable Medical equipment that is offered are: wheelchairs, knee scooters, walkers, canes, shower chairs, shower seats, commodes, stool risers, etc. Items are disinfected, cleaned, and have a thorough maintenance check prior to renting. The service is available to residents of Defiance, Fulton, Henry, and, Williams Counties. The Durable Medical Equipment Rental Business serves a need of the community, and also provides work







skills training to FHCC participants in the areas of cleaning, customer service, fiscal planning, inventory, and clerical responsibilities. Pictured above is Tara, and she is ready to help everyone with thier medical equiptment needs!
